Mediator Skills Training

The CEDR Mediator skills training is a five-day programme of comprehensive tuition in effective dispute resolution where participants are trained in the skills for **effective mediation of commercial disputes and assessed for CEDR Accreditation**, internationally recognised as the **standard of excellence**.

This training course satisfies the **Hong Kong Mediation Accreditation Association Ltd (HKMAAL)** Stage 1 General Mediator Accreditation Requirements which allows successful participants to apply for Stage 2 Assessment leading to accreditation as a HKMAAL Mediator.

Programme content

Days 1 and 2 - Skills and process are considered and tried in practical exercise. Case studies, based on actual mediations, are used and participants experience the role of mediator, adviser and party.

Day 3 - A practice day of shared learning. **Days 4 and 5** - Each delegate mediates simulated cases. A faculty member observes and provides guidance against a set of competencies.

CEDR One-day Workshop on HKMAAL Mediation Competences

This course is a separate 1 day elective programme which allows successful participants of the CEDR Mediation Skills Training to learn more about different Mediation Competences and how they compare. The course highlights the differences between different mediation competency models and would be particularly **useful for those who wish to undertake other assessments such as the HKMAAL Stage 2 Assessment**.

Prerequisites

These courses rely heavily on interactive teaching methodology. This demands a high level of competence in spoken English and comprehension from delegates.

Preparation

Participants will need to prepare thoroughly. A mediator handbook, case studies and role-plays are dispatched one month in advance.
